The 60-foot steel-hulled charter boat the **Holiday** will be sailing from the upper flats of the Cuyahoga River in Cleveland onto Lake Erie. This offshore birding pelagic will be a special charter sponsored by the Black Swamp Bird Observatory and Inside the Great Outdoors Radio.

The **Holiday** will cruise past the Black-crowned Night-Heron roost, through a blizzard of gulls on the river and then out into the lake. We will sail along the Lake Erie shoreline and out several miles into the lake, weather permitting. We plan to go cruise along the break wall of the harbor, the lakeside shore of Burke Lakefront Airport, past the new dredging spoils, Dike 14, offshore of both Wildwood and Edgewater Parks, and out into the lake. Bird sightings and winds will help determine our course.

The boat has two bathrooms (heads) and there will be beverages available in the deck house. Dress for the weather of the day, then think about it, and add another layer. The deck house is available for warm up, and a wrap-around covered deck with an open fore deck for good viewing. Bring popcorn, stale bread, etc. for gull "chumming".

Bring suitable layers of clothes to be prepared for all types of weather & bread & popcorn for chumming.

## Directions to the Holiday: 1800 Scranton Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44113

### FROM EAST: via I-90

Proceed west through "deadman's curve" – following I-90 west – across interbelt bridge.  
Move into right lane - Exit to right at West 14 St/Abbey Avenue (Exit #171).

*Note: Take left branch to West 14<sup>th</sup> Street However, do not go through traffic light*

Take right turn lane onto Fairfield Avenue.

Proceed down Fairfield hill to traffic light – Scranton Road – Turn right onto Scranton Road for 0.7 mile to dead-end at Carter Road. \*\* See parking directions at end of page

### FROM SOUTH: via I-77

Proceed north – Exit onto I-90 West/Toledo (Exit left, part of Exit 163)

Follow I-90 West, move into right lane promptly across Interbelt bridge.

Exit at 1<sup>st</sup> exit to right at West 14<sup>th</sup> Street/Abbey Avenue (Exit #171)

*Note: Take left branch to West 14<sup>th</sup> Street However, do not go through traffic light*

Take right turn lane onto Fairfield Avenue.

Proceed down Fairfield hill to traffic light – Scranton Road – Turn right onto Scranton Road for 0.7 mile to dead-end at Carter Road. \*\* See parking directions at end of page

### FROM SOUTH: via I-71

Proceed north – Exit West 14<sup>th</sup> Street/Clark Avenue (Exit 247A)

Stay in far left lane to navigate the "roundabout" – exit right onto West 14<sup>th</sup> Street, continue north on West 14<sup>th</sup> to the sixth traffic light.

First light – Bueher Avenue

Second light – Clark Avenue

Third light – Auburn Avenue

Fourth light – Starkweather Avenue

Fifth light – Kenilworth Avenue

**Sixth light – Fairfield Avenue**

**Turn left onto Fairfield Avenue, down hill to traffic light (Scranton Road)**

Turn right onto Scranton Road for 0.7 mile to dead-end at Carter Road. \*\* See parking directions

### FROM WEST: via I-90

Proceed east on I-90 to West 25<sup>th</sup> Street (Exit 170A)

At traffic light at top of ramp, continue straight across to Scranton Road.

Turn left onto Scranton Road for 1.4 miles, passing four traffic lights

First light – Barber Avenue

Second light – Starkweather Avenue

Third light – Kenilworth Avenue

**Fourth light – Fairfield Avenue**

Continue straight ahead to dead-end at Carter Road. \*\* See parking directions at end of page

### FROM THE WEST: via The West Shoreway

Proceed east on West Shoreway exit left at West 25<sup>th</sup> Street.

Move to right lane going down exit ramp; turn right onto West 25<sup>th</sup> Street.

Continue south on West 25<sup>th</sup> Street to first street on left (Franklin Blvd.)

*(If you get to Franklin Blvd. – at traffic light, you have gone too far!)*

Turn left onto Franklin Blvd., down hill to Columbus Road (Hooples on the right).

Continue straight across Columbus Road to Carter Road.

Follow around curving, narrow road – passing Epic Steel, cross railroad tracks, continue straight passing Cleveland Rowing Foundation and Riverfront Yacht Service to the left to Scranton Road Cleveland Fire Department (Engine Co. 21) and closed Eagle Street bridge ahead, old Jim's Steakhouse (now MEGA) to left.
